You will be **required** to keep a binder for this class.

The binder will need to be organized with divided sections for **notes**, **assignments** (homework), **quizzes**, **study guides**, and **graded tests**.

There will be one binder check during each of the nine weeks and it will be counted as a test grade. If you keep your binder nice and organized with all of your papers, it'll be an easy "A", right?!?

## homework & quizzes
