10 points will be deducted each day an assignment is past its due date. The assignment will not be taken one week after its due date and will be marked as a 0.

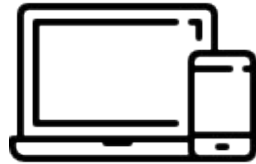
Students may redo any completed assignments lower than a 70 to a maximum grade of a 70.

ACADEMIC DISHONESTY
