
FFA Update

We are in the process of completing our state mandated Health screenings. Parents, if you have not submitted your Texas Senate Bill 12 consent form(s) for your child (children), please do so as soon as possible. This is in accordance with the new bill. As a parent or guardian, you have the right to consent (opt-in) or to withhold (opt-out) for all health-related and counseling services. We still have not received several of these consents from our HISD families. Please be on the lookout for any blank consent forms that are sent home to be filled out, or for messages & phone calls from our campuses, as we continue to collect these forms. If you realize you have not submitted these forms, please call your child's school campus or the school nurse.
