Classwork:

Students will be given time in class to work on assignments. This will include independent, partner, and group work. Some work will be turned in on the Chromebook through Google Classroom.

Homework:

If work is not completed in class, then it is considered homework. It can also be completed during enrichment.

Late or Missing Work:

Points will be deducted on any late assignment. Points will vary by assignment and the number of days late. Late work will only be accepted for up to **2 DAYS** past the original due date. After

that, the highest grade possible will be a 50. **Consistent** late work will result in penalty points and parent contact.

Failing Work:

If a student fails a daily grade or a test, it is the **student's** responsibility to meet with me to discuss corrections **within one week** of the grade being returned to the student. However, the new grade will not be raised higher than a 70. Parents will be notified if a student is **consistently** turning in late or failing assignments.

Absences:

Students have **2 days** upon return to school to complete assignments missed while absent. Students can check Google Classroom to complete work remotely or the absent folder inside the classroom upon return.

Cheating/Plagiarism:

Cheating or plagiarism will not be tolerated and will be handled accordingly: the student will receive a *zero* on that assignment. No exceptions. AI generated or enhanced writing is not permitted.

Classroom Rules:
